

Michigan Bowhunters Triple Crown Championship

GENERAL RULES:

1. You must be a Michigan Bowhunter member to compete.
2. You must shoot all three State events to qualify.
 - 3D Challenge
 - Rendezvous
 - Fred Bear Memorial Broadhead Shoot
3. You may not shoot alone in the Triple Crown Competition. Groups of 3 or more are preferred, but no more than 6 in a group.
3. Only bowhunting equipment will be allowed. No scopes with magnification. No binoculars or range finders. No stabilizers or sights over 15 inches beyond the front of the bow. The only exception is in the **Free Style Open** class.
4. You will only be able to compete in one class and compete in that class for all three legs of the competition.

SCORING:

Scores will be: Center heart, lung ring = 20 points
 Large vital ring = 15 points
 Body = 5 points
 Miss = 0 points

- Arrows touching the line will be scored at the higher score.
- Arrows must stick in the 3D targets to count (except Cub shooters).
- *Scoring for the Fred Bear Memorial Broadhead shoot leg will follow the broadhead shoot rules.
- Although bionic targets are on the course, you do not have to shoot them. Bionic targets will be optional and count 30 points if the arrow goes through the vital hole. If you do not make it through the hole, you will score a 0. If you choose not to shoot the bionic target and choose the regular target instead, the scoring will follow the regular rules. You may choose only one target. You can not get a double score for that target.
- Shoot only 1 arrow per target.
- One foot must be touching your stake.
- No one may walk up or spot targets before a shot.
- Only official MBH Triple Crown Score Cards will be accepted.
- Cards must be filled in completely, be readable, and turned in to qualify.
- Your scores will be recorded at each leg of the Triple Crown. At the end of the three legs, all three scores will be added together to get the Grand Total. In the event of a tie, the first shooter dropping the first point on the score card will take next lower place. The highest scores in each class will determine the winner for that class. Winners will be announced in the MBH News. Trophies will be awarded at the Awards Ceremony at the Spring Banquet Weekend the following spring.

All general 3D Shoot or Broadhead Shoot safety rules will apply at all Triple Crown Events.

CLASSES:

Free Style Open = This is a new open equipment class for MBH Members who compete in this competitive shooting style. Compound bow shot with release aid, glove, tab, or fingers.

You may use binoculars, and magnifying sights. You may use any length of stabilizer, and your sights may be moveable.

Bowhunter Freestyle = Compound bow, with or without sights. You may not use moveable sights in this class, only fixed pin type sights. Must be shot with a release.

Bowhunter Freestyle Limited = Compound bow, with or without sights. Must be shot with a glove, tab, or bare fingers. (Recurve, or Longbow if sights are used.)

Traditional = Recurve, or Longbow. No sights. Must be shot with a glove, tab, or bare fingers.

Adult = Male and Female, 18 years or older

Young Adult = Male and Female, 15 to 17 years old

Youth = Male and Female, 12 to 14 years old

Cub = Male and Female, 11 years old and younger

There will be a male winner from each class and a female winner from each class.
